## Journal Readership 2015-2016 (YTD) Accumulated Data





# **Common Questions**

- The cost of publishing?
  - GBP 300 per journal article
  - Approx. GBP 3,250 for a standard book (200 pages)
- Who makes decisions?
  - The Publishing Committee, based on recommendations from the editorial boards
- Which subject areas do you cover?
  - All the areas where there's a demand for reasonably priced OA publishing
  - An Editorial Board for the subject area is also needed
- What dissemination channels do you use?
  - OAPEN for online books
  - Amazon (INT) & Bokinfo (SWE) for Print-on-Demand books
  - Subject area databases & Search Engine Optimisation for journals (takes time to fulfil criteria)
- Approved by the Norwegian Register for Scientific Publishers (Level 1) & The Danish
